IB Diploma Results May 2016

St Catherine's British School is very pleased to announce the fine achievement of its IB Diploma candidates in this May's examination session. The key figures are as follows:

100% of the full Diploma candidates passed the IB Diploma.

(St Catherine's 2015: 98% IBO World 2015: 80%)

Average Diploma score was 35.9 points

(St Catherine's 2015: 35.8 points IBO World 2015: 30.2 points)

23% of cohort achieved more than 40 points.

(St Catherine's 2015: 25% IBO World 2015: 7%)

Once again we are delighted that our IB Diploma candidates are able to celebrate their achievements and are now able to look forward to studying at many of the finest universities and colleges in the world. The average Diploma score makes this already the third highest of our thirteen IB graduating cohorts since 2004 and, with probable re-marks to come during the summer, we are confident that it could yet prove to be our second best year on record!

Special congratulations go to our highest achiever, Harry Drake, who secured the maximum 45 points and has earned himself a place at the St John's College at Oxford University to read Oriental Studies.

During the summer we will receive final confirmation from the students' chosen universities and then we will be able to clarify this year's placement into Higher Education. We will send you a final confirmed outcome as to the results and university placement at the start of the new school year.
