IB Diploma Results May 2017

St Catherine's British School is very pleased to announce the fine achievement of its IB Diploma candidates in this May's examination session. The key figures are as follows:

98% of the full Diploma candidates passed the IB Diploma
(*IBO World 2016: 79%*)

Average Diploma total of 35.5 points
(*IBO World 2016: 30.0 points*)

17% of cohort achieved more than 40 points
(*IBO World 2016: 8%*)

Once again we are delighted that our IB Diploma candidates are able to celebrate their achievements and are now able to look forward to studying at many of the finest universities and colleges in the world. The average Diploma score is above the historical St Catherine's average and with probable re-mark upgrades to come during the summer, we are confident that it could yet prove to be our third or fourth best year on record!

Special congratulations go to our highest achievers: Danny Cronin, Ioannis Konsolakis and Meli Verouka who all secured 44 Diploma points. At this early stage we have two students who have successfully sealed their Oxbridge places and three students with confirmed UK Medical School positions as well as a host of others into other top UK and North American institutions.

During the summer we will receive final confirmation from the students' chosen universities and then we will be able to clarify this year's placements in Higher Education. We will send you a final confirmed outcome as to the results and university placement at the start of the new school year.
